

Sioux Lookout Skating Club Parent Commitment to Fundraising/Volunteer Policy: StarSkate Program August 2025

The Sioux Lookout Skating Club has always been committed to keeping our regular season rates at a reasonable cost. To keep costs reasonable it takes volunteers and fundraising events. The club offers all parents/guardians an option to fundraise a portion of the skating fees through various fundraising events. The option to opt-out of these fundraisers/volunteering are available with a payment of \$500, due **January 1, 2026**.

For the 2025-2026 skating season, families will only be required to participate in Fall and Spring fundraising and volunteer commitments. There will be no summer fundraising for this season. Beginning with the 2026-2027 season, fundraising activities will extend to include the summer of 2026. StarSkate Program Fundraising/Volunteer Policy Declaration:

I understand that if I do not pay the \$500 opt-out fee in full by January 1, 2026 (available through Uplifter), I am responsible for fulfilling all volunteer and fundraising expectations for the 2025–2026 skating season (September 1, 2025 – May 1, 2026).

I acknowledge that if these expectations are not met, I will be required to pay up to the \$500 opt-out fee. The final amount owing will be determined based on the level of participation in volunteer and fundraising commitments completed.

Update: Please note that moving forward, summer fundraising/volunteer obligations/commitments will be included in the season to follow and will not be included in the season that has already concluded. This means that summer 2026 is not included in this year's policy and will instead be included in the policy/expectations for the 2026-2027 season. The buyout for the 2025-2026 season has been adjusted accordingly.
